Field identification guide

Local Government Area

- Often grows in small groups
- Associated soil is a sandy loam on sandstone or conglomerate

Leaves

Grows only within a few areas near Denman in the Muswellbrook Shire

- Broadly oval with velvety short hairs
- Underside is pale green
